BART continues work on the subway portion of the Warm Springs Extension project through Central Park. As part of this work, the existing cofferdam at Lake Elizabeth is planned to be removed this fall. The removal will alter the current path, but maintain pedestrians' ability to complete the lake walk. To prepare for the removal of the cofferdam, this week, crews will add a temporary bridge. Pedestrians will be routed around the lake and not over the cofferdam as they are able to do currently. This new routing will be in place for approximately 3 weeks while construction crews complete work in the Lake Elizabeth area.
