QUALIFICATIONS

Membership in the BART Police Explorer program is open to all interested young men and women who pass an oral board, background check, and meet the following requirements:

- Age between 14 (and had completed the eighth grade) or 15 and up to 20 years old.
- If a student, maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.0 for each course taken, and a minimum of 2.5 GPA overall.
- Have parental approval if a minor
- If in possession of a driver license, maintain a good driving record.
- Be willing to be active and participate in Explorer activities (including, but not limited to, training, physical training, public service, department service, and social activities).
