

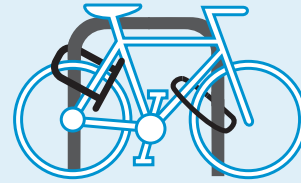


Lock It–Don't Lose It!

Theft Prevention Tips to Help Keep Your Bicycle Secure:

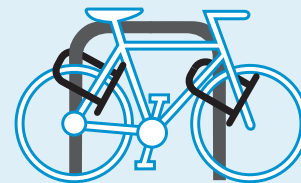
- Use highest quality U-lock, heavy-gauge chain, or handcuff-style lock. **Cable locks alone are easily cut.**
- Always lock your bike to a rack.
- Try to lock your bike in a well-lit, well-traveled area.
- Take any bike part that can be easily removed with you.

Fill out the form below and save it for your records

Having a detailed description of your bike is important proof of ownership and increases the chance that the stolen bike will be returned to you. Knowing the serial number is particularly important. It is usually found under the bottom bracket (the part of the frame where the pedal cranks revolve). Take photos of your bike and store them along with this completed form in a safe place.
