As part of the BART Warm Springs Extension Project, construction crews will continue the work to build a bridge across Walnut Avenue linking the existing BART line to the newly constructed subway. For safety reasons, some of this work must be done at night. This work will be done in two phases beginning Wednesday, July 9.

Phase 1: Both the eastbound and westbound directions on Walnut Avenue will be closed from Civic Center to BART Way Wednesday July 9 and Thursday, July 10 from 10:00 pm until 5:00 am.

Phase 2: Both the eastbound and westbound directions on Walnut Avenue will be closed from Civic Center to BART Way from Friday, July 11 at 10 pm until Monday, July 14 at 5:00 am.

From Walnut Avenue, motorists will be directed towards Mowry Avenue. Please observe the detours.

The work will include, but is not limited to:

- Installing changeable message signs
- Night time closure of east- and westbound lanes on Walnut Avenue near the station
- Removal of the bridge falsework
- Lowering of the west bridge
