
As part of the BART Warm Springs Extension Project, construction crews will begin modifying the southeast parking lot entrance at the Fremont Station starting August 31, 2015 (see map of impacted area on reverse). The easternmost driveway at Walnut Avenue will be temporarily closed. Vehicles will be restricted to only using the southwest driveway off Walnut Avenue, Civic Center Drive and Mowry Avenue for entering and exiting. The work will include, but is not limited to:

- Repaving, landscaping and other improvements in impacted area;
- Vehicle access into the station from the easternmost driveway on Walnut Avenue will be temporarily closed. Vehicles will be restricted to using only the southwest driveway off Walnut Avenue, Civic Center Drive and Mowry Avenue for entering and existing;
- Temporary shifting, narrowing and closing of drive aisles in southeast parking lot;
- Temporary closing of some parking; and
- Temporary sidewalk detours.

Please follow all posted parking and pedestrian detour signs and other notices regarding construction activities and safety information.
