

Construction Notification #002

Start of Soil Investigation Work

November 2010

As part of the Oakland Airport Connector (OAC) project, construction crews will begin conducting investigations along Hegenberger Road between Doolittle Drive and San Leandro Boulevard to gather soil data and locate underground utilities. **To lessen impacts to traffic in the area, the work will be performed during nighttime hours, 7 pm to 7 am.** The work activities will include:

- Placement of traffic signage and temporary closure of lanes on Hegenberger Road
- Crews using a truck-mounted boring device to drill into the ground to collect data
- Restoration of areas upon completion of the work

General work hours are 7 am to 7 pm Monday through Saturday with limited night work as necessary. Throughout construction you can expect lane closures and traffic impacts in the area and construction related noise, dust and inconvenience. We will attempt to keep these disruptions to a minimum and will provide advance notice of activities whenever possible.

Please watch for notices regarding future construction activities and signs with safety information. We appreciate your patience and cooperation during this work.
