Construction Notification #005 *Pile Driving and Start of Station and Guideway Construction*

June 2011

Beginning June 20, crews will begin construction of the Oakland Airport Connector (OAC) on BART property at San Leandro Street (between 73rd Avenue and Hegenberger Road).

Large equipment needed for construction will begin arriving on site as early as June 15. As part of the work, pile driving to provide foundation support for the station and guideway will be required, and will involve driving precast concrete piles into the soil with a large impact hammer. The work activities will include, but are not limited to:

- Delivery of a 175-foot pile driving crane and other large equipment and materials
- Driving concrete piles
- Clearing the work area, including cutting of concrete, and jackhammering
- Monitoring noise and vibration levels

Pile driving work will produce noise and vibrations in the immediate area. All efforts will be taken to minimize noise, vibration, and other disruptions to the community. Please watch for notices regarding future construction activities and signs with safety information. We appreciate your patience and cooperation during this work.
