A public celebration will be held on Friday, March 24, 2017 to mark this significant milestone in extending BART service to the South Bay. The event will include speeches by dignitaries, a ribbon cutting, entertainment, and light refreshments. BART will also have a new train on hand for public viewing.

Regular train service into the new station will NOT be running on March 24. Members of the public wishing to attend the Opening Celebration can drive to the new Warm Springs / South Fremont Station and park for free. A free shuttle from the west side (near the clock tower) of the Fremont BART Station to the event will run from 8:45 a.m. to 1 p.m., every 15 - 20 minutes. Regular BART service begins at the Warm Springs / South Fremont Station Saturday, March 25, 2017.

From I-880 S

Take the Auto Mall Parkway exit, EXIT 15.
Turn left onto Auto Mall Pkwy.
Turn right onto S Grimmer Blvd.
Turn right onto Warm Springs Blvd.
Warm Springs/South Fremont Station is on the right.

From I-880 N

Merge onto CA-262/Mission Blvd via EXIT 12A toward Sacramento/I-680.
Turn left onto Warm Springs Blvd.
Warm Springs/South Fremont Station is on the left.
