### ***Transit Vehicle Electronic Technician (TVET)***

#### **Education:**

An Associate of Science degree in electronics from an accredited community college or an Electronics Credential from an accredited electronics certificate program, or its equivalent (i.e. completion of a military electronics training program).

#### **Substitution:**

Four (4) years of verifiable electronic maintenance (troubleshooting, repair, and maintenance of electronic and/or electro-mechanical equipment) can be substituted for the education.

Must have adequate color vision; be physically capable of working in confining work spaces and lifting equipment weighing up to 70 pounds; Must be willing to work weekends, holidays, off hours and occasional emergency overtime.
