Construction Notification #55 Walnut Avenue Bridge Work To Include Night Work

Construction Details

Summary of Night Time Activity

- Close lanes on east/westbound Walnut Avenue
- Install K-Rail
- Erect Falsework

Estimated Start Date

April 14, 2014

Estimated Duration

Approximately two to three weeks

Impacts

- Traffic delays due to detour
- Increased dust and noise

General Work Hours

10 pm to 5 am week nights

April 11, 2014

As part of the BART Warm Springs Extension Project, construction crews will continue the work to build a bridge across Walnut Avenue linking the existing BART line to the newly constructed subway. For safety reasons this work must be done at night. Both Eastbound and Westbound directions on Walnut Avenue will be closed from Civic Center to BART Way starting the week of April 14th and lasting for approximately two to three weeks. From Walnut Avenue, motorists will be directed towards Mowry Ave. Please observe detour signs.

The work will include, but is not limited to:

- Installing changeable message signs
- Night time closure of east and westbound lanes on Walnut Avenue near the station
- Construct falsework in preparation for bridge construction
