## Measure RR Safe Routes to BART Cycle 3 Project Fact Sheet Contra Costa County's North Bailey Road Active Transportation Corridor

SR2B award (total project cost): \$900,000 (\$11.3 million)

**Project location**: Bailey Road between Willow Pass Road and Canal Road/State Route 4 westbound on-ramp **Project components**: Bailey Road is the only way to access the BART station for miles in either direction. The project will improve walking and biking for Bay Point residents, an equity priority community, by:


- Converting west side Class II bike lane to Class IV two-way cycle track with buffer
- Upgrading sidewalks and curb ramps on both sides of Bailey Road to be ADA compliant
- Installing high-visibility crossings for bicycle and pedestrians at four intersections
- Modifying traffic signal timing at three intersections for walking and biking access
- Installing new traffic signal equipment and lighting at one intersection
- Installing landscaping and irrigation

This project can start construction after gas, fiber optic cable, and electric lines are relocated by utility companies.

**SR2B funding:** Funds a portion of all elements of the project.

**Distance from station:** The closest intersection is 0.35 miles from the Pittsburg/ Bay Point BART station entrance.

Construction start (duration)\*: Summer 2026 (4 months)
