
- New crosswalks and protected intersections

- Streetscape improvements

SR2B funding: Supports the Class IV separated bikeways on San Pablo Avenue and Cutting Boulevard and bulb-outs at pedestrian crossings of Hill Street at Liberty Street and Lexington Avenue intersections

Distance from station: Adjacent to the El Cerrito del Norte BART station

Construction start (duration): March 2024 (1.5 years)
