

Measure RR Safe Routes to BART Cycle 1 Completed Project City of Dublin's Iron Horse Trail Bridge

SR2B award: \$1.5 million, 11% of the total estimated project cost of \$14 million

SR2B reimbursement and total project cost: \$1.5 million, 9% of actual project cost of \$16.6 million

Project location: Dublin Boulevard at the Iron Horse Trail crossing east of Scarlett Drive

Project components: This project has improved walking and biking by providing a grade-separated crossing at Dublin Boulevard at the Iron Horse Trail. It closes a major gap in this popular 30-mile Class I multi-use trail and makes access to and from the Dublin/Pleasanton BART station safer and quicker.


SR2B funding: Funded a portion of all elements of the project.

Distance from station: 0.4 miles from the Dublin/Pleasanton BART station entrance.

Construction start and end: April 2022 through November 2024 (19 months)
