On-Call GEC/CM & Project Specific Services is comprised of consultants (“Primes”) who perform work on projects under the Office of Infrastructure Delivery. BART’s Office of Infrastructure Delivery (“OID”) is offering the opportunity to any Primes with active Project/Work Plans to express interest in having their sponsored intern(s) work alongside them this summer at BART. This opportunity will also allow the Prime-Sponsored Interns to participate in any of BART’s Summer Engineering Internship activities, which typically includes various tours and informational sessions. Space is limited, and will be first come, first serve.

The opportunity will run from **June 15 – Aug 7, 2026.**

*This timeframe runs at the same time as BART’s Engineering Internship Program, and while it is suggested Prime-Sponsored Interns join for the same timeframe so that they can join BART’s Engineering Internship activities, it is not required.*

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

Junior or Senior in an undergraduate Engineering program or enrollment/completion of a Post-Graduate Engineering program

**DETAILS**

Primes are responsible for their sponsored intern(s), providing them with their own devices (i.e. laptops), and will work directly with BART personnel responsible for the Work Plan they are assigned to. Any BART work performed, must be performed on-site at BART Headquarters, or the Project site.

Prime-Sponsored Interns will be required to go through the same standard procedures as Primes, which includes a background check, mandatory trainings, and other additional security measures.
