



Resolution to Approve the FY27 Budget

Executive Summary

- FY27 operating budget of \$1.2B is balanced, using a combination of growing operating revenues, deferrals, cost reductions, borrowing, and one-time revenue sources
- FY27 capital budget of \$828M prioritizes system reinvestment and capacity enhancement work, and includes realistic, data-driven assumptions about the volume of capital work BART can deliver over the course of the year
- No changes have been made to the budget since it was last presented to the Board on May 28, 2026

Key Notes

- Current service levels and authorized position count
- Successful passage of a regional tax measure to authorize additional operating revenues
- \$52.4M of SB 125 is assumed to be carried forward from FY26
- Proposed operating budget includes elimination of 63 positions and \$28.2M of ongoing deficit reductions (\$18.2M in cuts and \$10.0M in increased revenue)

Potential or Expected Changes to FY27

- Impact of ongoing changes to amend CA Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund (GGRF) may negatively impact BART revenues
- Final FY26 year-end financial close will finalize FY26 SB 125 carry forward and update borrowing levels needed to balance FY27
- Interest income and debt service driven by borrowing amounts will also change
