This report contains statistical data compiled by the BART Police Office of Internal Affairs, addressing the number and nature of misconduct allegations resulting from Citizen Complaints and Administrative Investigations. Additionally, the report enumerates use of force statistics.

Annual Report

Internal Affairs Overview

The BART Police Office of Internal Affairs received 92 issues of concern from citizens with regards to police conduct during 2012.

- Of the 92 issues, 65 were reported and investigated as Formal Citizen Complaints.
- The remaining 27 issues were reported as Informal Citizen Complaints and were addressed through Supervisory Referrals.

There were 16 Administrative Investigations initiated by the Office of Internal Affairs.



Each incident is categorized by a primary allegation which is considered to be the most serious and/or significant allegation made against the officer. Sustained allegations are considered to be the primary allegation over non-sustained allegations.

The following data quantifies the primary allegations from citizens in 2016:







^{*}The above chart includes both complainants and witnesses involved in complaints. There was one case where the complainant's race and gender were unknown.


Demographics of BART Ridership:
