## Construction Update

### Nighttime work at Fruitvale Station

January 10, 2019

#### CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

##### Summary of Activity

Nighttime construction work at Fruitvale Station over the course of two consecutive nights starting as early as Monday, January 14 at approximately 11:00 pm. Each night, work activity will run from approximately 11:00 pm through the next morning, concluding at approximately 4:00 am. Work includes truck and forklift movements inside and outside the station to load/unload heavy equipment and materials during non-revenue hours.

##### Estimated Start Time

As early as Monday night, January 14 at 11:00 pm (approx.).

##### Estimated Duration

Approximately 4-5 hours at night into early morning over the course of two consecutive nights, week of January 14.

##### Impacts

- Some periodic noise and additional lighting related to forklift moves outside the northwest side of the station.

#### Dear Fruitvale Station Community,

BART systemwide Earthquake Safety Program, seismic retrofit construction at multiple locations inside and outside the Fruitvale Station continues and REMAINS OPEN for BART riders.

Nighttime work is planned to accommodate heavy construction delivery and work activity at Fruitvale Station during BART's blanket hours over the course of two consecutive nights, starting as early as **Monday, January 14 at approximately 11:00 pm. Each night, work activity will run from approximately 11:00 pm through the next morning, concluding at approximately 4:00 am.** Work during this time will allow for safe delivery and light construction that will also minimize traffic and commute impacts. This nighttime activity is related to the BART systemwide Earthquake Safety Program, seismic retrofit construction occurring at multiple locations inside and outside the Fruitvale Station. Nighttime work will be concentrated near the Station main entrance.

During the day, construction continues at a robust pace in and around **Fruitvale Station, which REMAINS OPEN for BART riders during construction.** We appreciate your patience and cooperation during this work. As always, safety is BART's top priority. Our aim is to complete seismic retrofit work as quickly as possible, while maintaining BART service.

<p>Under BART alignment, near <i>Avenida de la Fuente</i>, AC Transit bus bays, and parking garage, located north of Fruitvale Station entrance expands and <b>CONTINUES</b>.</p> <p><b>Note: Other non-BART Earthquake retrofit construction activity is also occurring in the area.</b></p>	<p>Inside BART Fruitvale Station in the Concourse area <b>CONTINUES</b>. All escalators, stairs, elevators, add-fare and parking machines are accessible with detours. <b>Please allow additional time for travel through Fruitvale BART Station following all directional signage.</b></p>	<p>Under the BART alignment, outside the station, located next to 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue on the north side closest to the station building and Bus bay entrance <b>CONTINUES</b>.</p>	<p>Located south of the Fruitvale Station and 35<sup>th</sup> Avenue, between the Fee parking lot and Fruitvale Village Phase 2 construction area continues and is <b>NEARING COMPLETION</b> – expected early 2019, weather permitting.</p>

**Note:** During Construction, Fruitvale BART Station is **expected to remain open and accessible with some detours and directional signage**. Additionally, earthquake safety retrofit construction is occurring at Coliseum Station, primarily outside the station.
