Construction Update

at Fruitvale Station – 2/25 Temp Detours

February 21, 2019

Dear Fruitvale Station Community,

BART systemwide Earthquake Safety Program, seismic retrofit construction at multiple locations inside and outside the Fruitvale Station CONTINUES and REMAINS OPEN for BART riders.

On Monday, February 25, 2019, AC Transit lines will make a temporary shift in stop moves from approximately 5:00 am to 12:00 noon in the AC Transit bus bays located just west of the main Fruitvale Station entrance to accommodate earthquake safety retrofit construction. You will see a concrete truck temporarily stationed in the Bus Bay positioned near the main entrance for approximately 7 hours between 5 am and 12 noon.

We recognize the inconvenience and appreciate your patience and cooperation during this work. As always, safety is BART's top priority. Please pay attention to directional signage and allow additional travel time. Our aim is to complete seismic retrofit work as quickly as possible, while maintaining BART service.

AC Transit will make a temporary shift in stop moves at **Fruitvale Station** on Monday morning (2/25) to accommodate Earthquake Safety retrofit construction at Fruitvale Station.

Estimated Activity Date

Bus stop temporary moves on Monday, February 25, 2019.

Work Hours

Approximately 5:00 am to 12:00 noon.

Estimated Duration

Approximately 7 hours.

Impacts

- AC Transit line(s) will make a temporary shift in stop moves related to construction activity and concrete truck temporarily stationed in the Bus Bay, located west of the main BART Fruitvale Station entrance.
- Intermittent lane and sidewalk closures/detours and traffic delays

<p>Under BART alignment, near <i>Avenida de la Fuente</i>, AC Transit bus bays, and parking garage, located north of Fruitvale Station entrance construction activity CONTINUES.</p> <p>Note: Other non-BART Earthquake retrofit construction activity is also occurring in the area.</p>	<p>Inside BART Fruitvale Station in the Concourse area CONTINUES. All escalators, stairs, elevators, add-fare and parking machines are accessible with detours. Please allow additional time for travel through Fruitvale BART Station following all directional signage.</p> <p>Work inside the Station is NEARING COMPLETION – expected Spring 2019.</p>	<p>Under the BART alignment, outside the station, located on the north side of 35th Avenue, closest to the backside of the station building and near Bus Bay entrance, construction CONTINUES.</p> <p>On Monday, February 25 from approximately 5:00 am to 12:00 noon, a large truck will be placed in the AC Transit Bus Bay for temporary construction activity. Please use caution and observe all signage; and allow additional travel time.</p>	<p>Located south of the Fruitvale Station between 35th Avenue and 36th Avenue (and Fee parking lot) construction continues and is NEARING COMPLETION – expected Spring 2019, weather permitting.</p> <p>Note: A separate project, Fruitvale Village Phase 2 (Transit Oriented Development – Affordable Housing) construction is actively occurring adjacent to the BART Earthquake Safety Program location between 35th and 36th Avenue.</p>

Note: During Construction, Fruitvale BART Station is **expected to remain open and accessible with some detours and directional signage**. Additionally, earthquake safety retrofit construction is occurring at Coliseum Station.
