Nighttime work at Coliseum Station

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

Summary of Activity

Nighttime construction work at Coliseum Station over the course of a few nights, starting approximately Monday, March 4 at 11:00 pm. This work will include nighttime activity with light truck and forklift movements inside and outside station to load/unload equipment and materials to support utility work during non-revenue hours.

Estimated Start/End Time

Monday, March 4 at approximately 11:00 pm to 4:00 am through Friday, March 8.

Estimated Duration

Approximately 5 hours at night into early morning, over the course of approximately 3 days.

Impacts

- Some periodic noise and additional lighting related to forklift moves inside and outside the Coliseum Station off San Leandro Street.

Dear Coliseum Station Community,

Nighttime work planned to accommodate utility construction during BART's blanket, non-service hours, starting as early as Monday, March 4 continuing over the course of approximately 3 nights. This activity is related to the BART systemwide Earthquake Safety Program, seismic retrofit construction occurring at multiple locations inside and outside the Coliseum Station. Despite the rains, construction continues at a robust pace and **Coliseum Station REMAINS OPEN for BART riders during construction.** Similar construction is also occurring at Fruitvale Station. Noise, dust, and odors will be monitored, and local regulations will be enforced to minimize any inconveniences. Please adhere to all safety and directional signage.

We apologize for the inconvenience and appreciate your patience and cooperation during this work. As always, safety is BART's top priority. Our aim is to complete seismic retrofit work as quickly as possible, while maintaining BART service.

<p>Under BART alignment, outside the Coliseum Station, just south of the building, off San Leandro Street, construction continues and is NEARING COMPLETION – expected Spring 2019.</p>	<p>Under BART alignment, outside the Coliseum Station, north of the Station building is under construction in the ADA and BART parking lot located off San Leandro Street. ADA parking has been temporarily relocated north of its permanent location under the BART alignment off San Leandro Street. Please allow additional time for travel to/from and through Coliseum BART Station following all directional signage.</p>	<p>Inside BART Coliseum Station on the south-end of the Concourse under the BART alignment. Stage 1 temporarily closed the south escalator. Stage 2 is expected to start on March 1, 2019, reopening the south escalator and temporarily closing the southwest stairwell between the Concourse and Platform. This work is expected to proceed for approximately 4 months. All escalators, stairs (except southwest stairwell), elevators, add-fare and parking machines are accessible with detours. Work at the Coliseum Station in this work area CONTINUES.</p>	<p>Located on the west side of San Leandro Street under the Coliseum Pedestrian Bridge, seismic retrofit work is expected to begin in a few months. Currently, there is NO CONSTRUCTION activity impacting pedestrian access.</p>

Note: During Construction, Coliseum BART Station is expected to remain open and accessible with some detours and directional signage. We apologize for the inconvenience. Thank you for your patience.
