Nighttime work at Coliseum Station

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

Summary of Activity

Nighttime construction work at Coliseum Station over the course of a few nights will include light truck and forklift movements along with some heavy drilling inside the station for utility work and installation of temporary structures.

Estimated Start/End Time

Tuesday night, March 26 at approximately 11:00 pm to 4:00 am nightly for approximately 3 days through Thursday night, March 28.

Estimated Duration

Approximately 5 hours at night into early morning, over the course of approximately 3 days.

Impacts

 Some periodic noise and additional lighting related to forklift moves and drilling inside the Coliseum Station off San Leandro Street.

Dear Coliseum Station Community,

Nighttime work inside Coliseum Station to accommodate utility and installation of temporary structures construction is expected to start Tuesday, March 26 at approximately 11:00 pm nightly through BART's blanket, non-service hours, continuing over the course of approximately 3 nights. Most activities are quiet, except some drilling. Sound barrier blankets will be used to assist with noise levels. Noise, dust, and odors will be monitored, and local regulations will be enforced to minimize any inconveniences. During late night travel through the Station, please adhere to all safety and directional signage. This activity is related to the BART systemwide Earthquake Safety Program, seismic retrofit construction occurring at multiple locations inside and outside the Coliseum Station. Despite the rains, construction continues at a robust pace and Coliseum Station REMAINS OPEN for BART riders during construction. Similar construction is also occurring at Fruitvale Station.

We apologize for the inconvenience and appreciate your patience and cooperation during this work. As always, safety is BART's top priority. Our aim is to complete seismic retrofit work as quickly as possible, while maintaining BART service.
