THE BASE BID OR COMBINATION OF THE BASE BID AND ADDITIVE BID A WILL NOT EXCEED THE FUNDING AMOUNT WHICH WILL BE REVEALED AT THE TIME OF BID OPENING.

THE DISTRICT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY AND ALL BIDS.

1. It will not make any monetary or in-kind contribution (including loans) to any BART Director, or any candidate for Director, from the date Bids are opened by the District until Award of the Contract.
2. It understands that the term "contribution" shall have the same meaning as defined in California Government Code Section 82015 and implementing regulations adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission.
3. If Bidder is awarded the Contract, the undersigned shall continue to comply with this prohibition for three months following Award of the Contract.
