The Work to be done is located in the County of San Mateo, State of California, and is to be done in accordance with the Contract Documents which include the Contract Drawings and the referenced sections of BART Facilities Standards, Standard Specifications, Release - R3.0, dated January 2013, and the Contract Book incorporating the General Conditions, Supplementary Conditions, Contract Specifications, and other documents as listed therein.
