### More station capacity and modernization improvements planned

BART is working on a plan to **improve the capacity at BART's two busiest stations – Embarcadero and Montgomery**. Ridership has been growing for the last several years, and BART has been working with partner agencies to develop a number of concepts to handle the increased demand.

**As funding becomes available**, BART plans to incrementally enhance the capacity of the stations with:

1. a **new platform elevator at Embarcadero**,
2. adding **stairs and escalators at the two stations**,
3. a **new elevator at Montgomery**, and
4. potentially adding **platform screen doors** (like on the BART to OAK Line and SFO AirTrain) for more efficient and safe use of platform space.



5. Ultimately, BART may build **new side platforms** to provide additional platform space.

As part of its BETTER BART campaign, BART is also identifying **modernization needs to improve station functionality, safety, access, appearance, and the overall customer experience**.

BART is coordinating this work with San Francisco's Better Market Street Plan, the new Transbay Terminal project, and the SFMTA's Waterfront Transportation Assessment. BART continues to work on developing a coordinated approach to implementation with partner agencies, identify funding for the projects, and to proceed in a phased manner to implement the improvements.
