

# Law Enforcement Security Enhancement Program (LESEP)



## Program Details

Since 1974, BART has enhanced security and increased the number of police officers in the system by providing free rides to fully sworn peace officers from agencies within the BART service area. The Law Enforcement Security Enhancement Program (LESEP) is one of several planned BART system improvements which is designed to further enhance system security. LESEP originally came about as a result of BART's Inter-Departmental Task Force on Fare Evasion in an effort to reduce fare evasion in the BART system, which costs BART millions of dollars annually. As part of LESEP, BART will provide secured BART system access to active, full-time, sworn officers and district attorney investigators from authorized S.F. Bay Area law enforcement agencies through the use of BART ID smartcards, also known as LEO Passes. Some of the major objectives of LESEP are:

- Minimize BART Station swing gate usage, fraud and potential Station Agent issues
- Maximize BART's control of swing gates by providing secured smartcard BART system access for Peace Officers
- Enhance public safety by adding police presence in the BART system

## Eligibility

To be eligible, a Peace Officer must:

- Have the authority to carry a firearm while off-duty
- Be employed with one of the participating agencies (see list below)

## Scheduling Appointments

To schedule an appointment, send an email to [bartidbadge@bart.gov](mailto:bartidbadge@bart.gov). Include the following information in the email:

Name of Agency  
Whether or not you are authorized to carry a firearm off-duty

If you are found eligible for this pass, you will receive a response to your email with a link to set up an appointment and to download the request form.

## **Prior to your LESEP Appointment:**

Bring the following to the **BART Police Department located at 101 8th Street, Oakland CA:**

- LESEP Badge Request Form
- Current valid driver's or government issued ID
- Law enforcement agency badge and credentials

BART Police Department will validate your law enforcement badge and credentials and stamp the LESEP Badge Request Form. Walk-in credential validation hours are Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. All LESEP badge applicants are required to have all credentials validated.

## **Day of your scheduled LESEP Appointment:**

All LESEP badge applicants must bring the following to Human Resources located at **2150 Webster St, 4th Floor, Oakland, CA:**

- Completed and stamped LESEP Badge Request Form
- Current valid driver's license or government issued ID
- Law enforcement agency badge and credentials
- \$70 exact cash or check (payable to BART)

At your scheduled appointment, payment is due, your photo will be taken, and your badge will be issued.

## **LEO Pass Replacement**

The LEO Pass contains electronics. Accordingly, care should be taken in the handling of the card. Responsibility for any damage to the LEO Pass is assumed by requesting officer. Lost or damaged LEO Passes can be replaced by sending an email to [bartidbadge@bart.gov](mailto:bartidbadge@bart.gov). Any replacement of LEO Passes (whether damaged or loss) will incur an additional \$35 processing fee, payable with cash (exact change) or check (payable to BART).
