Fish Capture and Release in Lake Elizabeth

April 21, 2010

Dewatering of the northeastern lobe of Lake Elizabeth is needed in advance of the start of subway construction under the lake. To protect the fish and preserve the lake environment, a fish catch-and-release activity, approved by the California Department of Fish and Game, will begin in late April. This effort is expected to last two weeks and will include ongoing biological monitoring.

A map showing the work area is located on the opposite side of this notification. The work will include, but is not limited to:

- Setting up fencing to define the contractor's work area
- Setting up a silt curtain to section off the northeastern lobe from main part of lake
- Installation of a cofferdam, a temporary water-tight structure that is used to isolate the work area
- The use of nets to collect the fish and release into another part of the lake
- Dewatering a section of Lake Elizabeth

Fencing will be installed to isolate the work area.
