## Parking – Pleasant Hill BART

Daily Fee Parking is available on a first-come/first-served basis. You need to pay a daily fee to park at BART stations. The fee varies by station and is posted at each station. Daily fee parkers may park in the designated "Fee" area of a station, where fees are required Monday through Friday from 4:00 am to 3:00 pm.

BART stations will be closed between 4:00 am – 5:00am on weekdays. Stations will open at 5:00 am. Parking fee payment between 4:00 am – 5:00 am will be accepted using the following ways:

- **BART Mobile App:** BART offers the official BART app available on both iOS App Store and Google Play Store, our mobile site [m.bart.gov](http://m.bart.gov) and email and text alerts. Please download the BART Mobile App on your Smart Phone, select Station, enter parking stall number, and pay daily parking fee (credit, debit, PayPal).
- **Hang Tags:** Available for purchase at Lake Merritt Customer Service Center and Embarcadero Clipper Office.
- **Select-a-spot:** Single day permits can be purchased via [select-a-spot.com/bart](http://select-a-spot.com/bart). Riders are required to print out a single day permit and display it on the front dashboard of the vehicle.

**To get to Pleasant Hill BART from Walnut Creek BART**

- Walk 2.1 miles for 42 minutes
- Bike 2.1 miles for 11 minutes
- Ride taxi, Lyft, or Uber for 7 minutes and pay \$5-\$10

- **EBX Route 713:** To San Francisco International Airport and Millbrae
- **EBX Route 714:** To 16<sup>th</sup> Mission, 24<sup>th</sup> Mission, Glen Park, Balboa Park, and Daly City
- **Muni Route 5:** To Embarcadero, Montgomery, Powell, and Civic Center
- **Muni Route 14 (go to Mission):** To Montgomery, Powell, Civic Center, 16<sup>th</sup> Mission, 24<sup>th</sup> Mission, and Daly City
- **Muni Route 38:** To Embarcadero, Montgomery and Powell
- **Muni Metro KT/J/M/L (go to Market):** To Montgomery, Powell, and Civic Center
- **Muni Route K-OWL/L-OWL/N-OWL (go to Market):** To Montgomery, Powell, and Civic Center
