

Take BART to Disney's Frozen at the Orpheum Theatre in San Francisco

BART's Civic Center station is located right outside the Orpheum's entrance.

Paying For Your Trip

- Each rider 5 and older needs a Clipper card.
- If you don't already have a Clipper card, save \$3 per plastic card, and add Clipper to your phone's digital wallet for free.
- No app required.
- Instantly load cash value with your Apple Wallet or Google Wallet.
- Multiple digital cards can be added to one phone's wallet for families riding together.
- When you arrive to the fare gate, tag your phone at the Clipper reader. Tag in with each separate digital card in your wallet.

Check Train Departure Times

- Use our Trip Planner on **bart.gov** or our official app to reduce the amount of wait time.
- Check real time departures before leaving your house to look out for cancelled trains and right when the show ends to avoid just missing a train.

Parking is Free Evenings & Weekends

• BART Parking is free after 3pm and on weekends, except at Milpitas and Berryessa where there is a fee.

Getting to the Orpheum

- Exit at Civic Center Station, follow the Orpheum Theatre directional decals to the center of the platform where there are escalators up.
- Take the "Market & Hyde St. Exit A2" staircase and the Orpheum is right there!
- There are currently no escalators to the street level on the Orpheum end of the station due to modernization projects.
- Need an elevator? The platform elevator is located at the end of the platform. This elevator goes to the concourse and then the elevator to the street level is in the middle of the station. Once at street level, head towards the left on Market Street and the Orpheum is one block away on the same side of the street. Both elevators have an attendant for your safety.

Ride Safe

- BART will have extra staff in the system to increase visible presence.
- We recommend riding in the first car where the train operator is.
- If you see anything concerning, text BART Police at (510) 200-0992 or use the train car intercom.
